Written applications are invited for the temporary full time position of Apprentice Mechanic (first year), based at the Longreach Workshop. Second and third year apprentices are also encouraged to apply. Applications will be received until **Friday 27 January 2023**. Late applications may not be accepted.

### The Position

The position is responsible for supporting the effective and efficient operations of the Longreach workshop team, whilst developing their skills in a relevant trade qualification. The position is responsible for providing assistance to Council's tradespersons employed in the area of mechanics.

### Qualifications and Experience

The successful applicant will need good results in Mathematics, English and Technical Skills. The apprentice will be exposed to on the job practical experience and theory components at a training organisation throughout the year. The successful applicant will be required to attend training blocks at a nominated training organisation for multiple periods of up to 8 weeks per year. The nominal term of apprenticeship is until completion of your apprenticeship, employment is not guaranteed past completion of the trade certificate. To be considered for this role, candidates must have a minimum completion of Year 10 Junior Certificate. The incumbent will have a Construction Induction Card, and be physically capable of performing manual tasks.

### Salary and Conditions

This fulltime apprenticeship and is for a 4 year time period until the completion of your apprenticeship. Wages will be in accordance with the Apprentices' and Trainee's Wages and Conditions with the parent award Queensland Local Government Industry (Stream C) Award – State 2017, as amended by Council's Certified Enterprise Bargaining Agreement, and will be subject to age and educational qualifications:
