The Position

Council is seeking the services of multiple people to fill the positions of Horticulture & Town Services Officer in Longreach. The successful applicant will be responsible for ensuring that the daily operations and maintenance requirements of all streetscapes and greenspaces are undertaken to the highest standard, including, but not limited to, main business area, public open spaces, tourist recreation areas, reserves, civic spaces, sporting fields, pedestrian and cycle ways, parks, playgrounds, botanical walkways and cemeteries.

Qualifications and Experience

The successful applicant is expected to have demonstrated experience in horticulture maintenance duties and hold a current MR class driver's licence and construction white card. Applicants are expected to have, be working towards, or have the ability to obtain competencies in chainsaw operation, chemical handling, traffic management and traffic control. The successful incumbent must have or be willing to obtain their Certificate III in Parks and Gardens.
