A superlative service (as is reasonably practicable) is to be provided to all users of water and sewerage infrastructure throughout the Ilfracombe Branch, through the maintenance and installation of infrastructure in an effective and safe efficient manner. It is also necessary that steps are taken to ensure that the maintenance and optimal operation of the Ilfracombe Town Spa and Pool is undertaken with safety of users of the facilities prioritised
