The changes to the conditions relate to the following:

- The decision notice only approves 'internal road works' and not all road works shown on the
 approved swept path plans because the proposed turn-out upgrades onto Cramsie-Muttaburra
 Road are within the jurisdiction of the Department of Transport and Main Roads to assess and
 approve. New Advisory Notes have been included to this effect.
- Update to the property description because the former lots under the original approval have since been amalgamated into a single lot as described in this amended approval.
- Inclusion of revised stormwater drawings and swept path plans. Inclusion of condition for drawings to be certified by a Registered Professional Engineer of Queensland prior to commencement of works.
- Hours of construction also include Sundays where no noise generating activities occur.
- Erosion and sediment controls (ESC) measures to comply with the prescribed standards under the current Planning Scheme, as opposed to the original approved ESC plan.
- Supervision Certification able to be undertaken by a licenced surveyor, given the applicant's RPEQ engineer is not based in Longreach.
- No requirement for as constructed drawings because approved civil works are yet to take place.
- Other changes have been made for clarity.

- i. via the internal swept paths shown, the internal manoeuvring ability of the largest design vehicle for the site, being a triple road train; and
- ii. new pavement treatment internal to the site as a result of upgrading the turn outs onto Cramsie Muttaburra Road.

Where external to the site, road work for the turn outs onto Cramsie Muttaburra Road are within the jurisdiction of the Department of Transport and Main Roads to assess and approve. Refer to Advisory Note (B) for more information.

Note: Please amend drawing AUR Q 0675 0007 to allow for suitable movement of triple road trains at the entry to the loading area. Your attention is drawn to swept paths on preliminary drawing no. 160001 1/01 demonstrating that the current design requires revision by the applicant.

Additional Details

- 2.3 The applicant/developer is required to provide additional detail on the set out of the retention basins weir, to ensure:
 - A minimum freeboard of 0.9 m between the weir crest and the crest of the sedimentation system embankment.
 - The system is capable of discharging the peak flow from a 50 year ARI design storm without the system embankment overtopping.

Decision notice and approved plans/drawings to be retained on site

2.2 A copy of this decision notice and stamped approved plans/drawings must be retained on site at all times. This decision notice must be read in conjunction with the stamped approved plans to ensure consistency in construction, establishment and maintenance of approved works.

3. AMENITY

Hours of Construction

- Unless otherwise approved in writing by Longreach Regional Council, approved hours of construction are:
 - 3.1.1 between the hours of 6.30am to 6.30pm Monday to Saturday (excluding Public Holidays); and
 - 3.1.2 between the hours of 6:30am to 6:30pm on Sunday where not involving noise generating activities.

4. CONSTRUCTION WORKS

During the course of construction works

- 4.1 Ensure that the works are carried out by a qualified competent contractor acceptable to Council;
- 4.2 Accept responsibility for all aspects of the works, including public safety;
- 4.3 Ensure adequate barricades, signage and other warning devices are in place at all times;
- 4.4 Ensure constructing contractor submits a Traffic Management Plan to Council and TMR Barcaldine for any works to be carried out within 30m of the Cramsie Muttaburra road centre line; and
- 4.5 A minimum of 10 million of Public Liability Insurance and Workers Compensation Insurance must be secured at all times throughout the construction and maintenance periods by the developer/contractor.

COUNCIL AND PUBLIC UTILITY SERVICES AND INFRASTRUCTURE

Repair damaged infrastructure and/or services

Any damage which is incurred to underground services, signs, footpaths, roadways and/or kerb and channelling as a result of the proposed works must be repaired immediately should hazards exist for the public or construction workers. Otherwise, all damage must be repaired immediately upon completion of works associated with the development and prior to acceptance of the as constructed works by Longreach Regional Council.

6. EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL

Implement Erosion and Sediment Control Measures

6.1 Erosion and sediment control measures must be carried out in accordance with the approved drawings-ESC Standards prescribed in Schedule 5.1.2 Design Standards, SC5.1.2.5 Earthworks, Erosion and Sediment Control of the *Longreach Regional Planning Scheme (V2.1)*.

EARTHWORKS

Earthworks to be as per approved plans

7.1 All earthworks must be undertaken and constructed in accordance with the approved drawings and documents. submitted as part of the application for operational works.

8. STORMWATER

No ponding or nuisance from stormwater on adjoining properties

- 8.1 All land adjoining the development must be protected from ponding or nuisance from stormwater resulting from the development works.
- 8.2 The applicant/developer must provide a stormwater connection at no cost to Council from the boundary of the site to a legal point of discharge as indicated on approved drawings.

9. SIGNAGE

Signage and line marking

9.1 All access/egress points within the site must be adequately signed. All signage is to be installed and/or modified in accordance with the Department of Transport and Main Roads Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD).

10. CERTIFICATION OF WORKS

Certification of Works

- 10.1 A certified copy of the approved drawings by a Registered Professional Engineer of Queensland Civil must be provided to Council for endorsement by the Director of Infrastructure Services or other authorised delegate prior to commencement of the works.
- 10.12 A supervision certificate completed by a Registered Engineer of Queensland Civil (RPEQ) licensed surveyor must be provided upon completion of all operational works certifying that the works have been completed in accordance with the approved plans and specifications. The certification can be provided in the form of a licensed survey report referencing the design drawings with a cover letter.
- 10.23 A Registered Professional Engineer of Queensland Civil preforming any task or function associated with the proposed works must hold professional indemnity to the value of \$5 million or otherwise to the satisfaction of Council.

11. AS CONSTRUCTED DRAWINGS

Prepare as constructed drawings for endorsement

11.1 Two (2) copies of as constructed drawings for all operational works, completed inspections, test results and RPEQ supervision certificate must be lodged with Council for endorsement of the Manager of Engineering Services.

Note: Prior to submission of as constructed drawings please discuss requirements for as constructed drawings with Council.

Advisory Notes:

Advisory Note (B) - Works on a State-Controlled Road

The property is accessed from Cramsie-Muttaburra Road, which is a State-controlled Road and within the jurisdiction of the Department of Transport and Main Roads (DTMR). It is an offence under the *Transport Infrastructure Act 1994* to carry out road access works on a State-controlled Road without written approval from DTMR. The approved plans showing intersection works between the property boundary and Cramsie-Muttaburra Road must therefore be approved by DTMR prior to works commencing. Swept paths and pavement upgrades internal to the property, as per approved plans with the reference number 20-3181-014 and 20-3181-015, are within the jurisdiction of Council and have been approved.

Advisory Note (C) - Aboriginal Cultural Heritage

This approval in no way removes the duty of care responsibility of the applicant under the *Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Act 2003*. Pursuant to section 23(1) of the *Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Act 2003*, a person who carries out an activity must take all reasonable and practicable measures to ensure the activity does not harm Aboriginal cultural heritage (the "cultural heritage duty of care").
